

How to get Kunstquartier Bethanien?

Kunstquartier Bethanien is a well know cultural institution located at Mariannenplatz (Mariannenplatz 2). An impressive building after a hospital serves as a place for exhibitions, concerts, workshops, and many other cultural activities.

The easiest way to get to Kunstquartier Bethanien is to reach S-Bahn or U-Bahn station Kottbuser Tor. The stations are located at a rondo. From there, you need to get to Skalitzer Strasse and go along the street till reaching the intersection of Skalitzer Str. – Mariannenstrasse. Turn left to Mariannestrasse and walk straight until getting a small park Feuerwehrbrunnen. The park has a semicircular shape, so you need to walk left, walking in $\frac{1}{4}$ circle each, then continue straight forward until getting to the main entrance to the building. You will have it on your left. On your right, you will have Mariannenplatz, surrounded by the park. The main entrance is the main exit at the same time.

How to get the Projectroom?

The exhibition Membranes out of order will be in one of the exhibition spaces in the Kunstquartier Bethanien building: Projectroom.

Projectroom is located on the ground floor. Crossing the main door, you will enter the main hall. Move straight forward. On the opposite side of the hall, precisely in front of the main entrance door, you will find a door to the main ground floor corridor. Turn right and follow the wall on your right. At some moment, you will find a break in the wall, which will be the entrance to the Projectroom's vestibule.
